	<ul> <li>To comment on new track, hard surfaces and electricity box in connection with use of land as Camp Site (retrospective)</li> <li>Oaklands Farm, Bodiam Road, Sandhurst, TN18 5LE</li> <li>The Chairman asked the meeting for comments: <ul> <li>Cllr Hiscock had visited the site and confirmed a road, electricity and other amenities were already in place to accommodate caravans.</li> <li>Cllr Leggett asked why a planning application had been made when permission was not required ?</li> <li>Cllr Griggs queried the need for a hard surface track for 5 caravans when most of the visitors would come in summer so it would not be a necessity.</li> <li>Cllr Hiscock said the stile to the footpath appears to have been moved and the footpath widened.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Following discussion Cllr Leggett proposed; Cllr O'Brien seconded and the Councillors agreed to object to the planning application on the grounds of insufficient information and asked :</li> </ul>

	<ol> <li>for clarification about why is there a planning application when one is not required ?</li> <li>for clarification about what is required ?</li> <li>it is unclear why a hard surface is needed for caravans.</li> <li>it appears PROW WC288 has been altered without consent ?</li> </ol> The Clerk was asked to take the above to TWBC's Planning Department, together with a request for an extension to the deadline.
